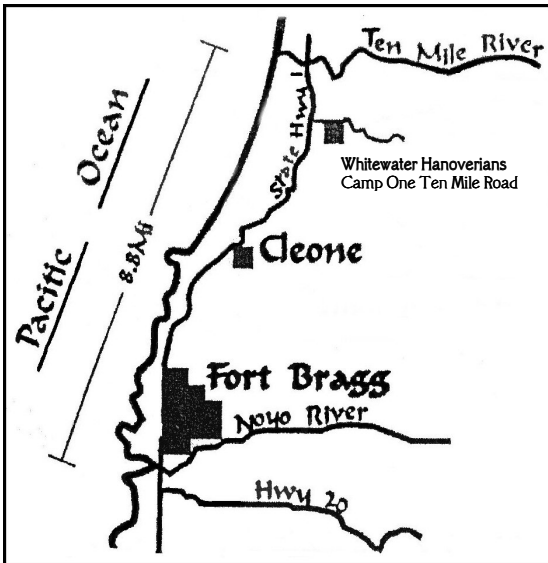

Dressage Show Rules

1. Rules and Tests - "Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current (2010) United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

ALL competitors are responsible for knowing the current rules.

2. Dressage Seat Equitation - (as per USEF DR132(1)) Open to riders who have not competed above 2nd Level in a CDS Recognized competition. To be shown in a group at the working walk, trot, and canter (Open Class only) both directions of the ring. Judge may ask for independent execution of specific movements. Riders will be judged on position, seat and correct use and effect of the aids required of Training and First Level dressage tests.

Dressage Suitability Under Saddle - Open - To be judged on the horse's potential to become a "dressage" mount. To be shown in a group at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring.

3. Riding Times - First group class begins at **9:30 am**. Riders will be contacted two days prior to the show with their individual riding time(s).

4. Management - Reserves the right to cancel, change, combine or amend classes.

5. Footing - Full size competition arena 20m x 60m sand; warm up arena 20m x 40m sand.

6. Stabling - Contact **Ronni McMahon, Whitewater Hanoverians 707-964-7625 (rhoni_mc1@hotmail.com)** \$25.00/night.

7. Parking - Available for both trailers and cars.

8. Dogs - For safety reasons, dogs are **NOT** allowed ANYWHERE on the grounds. Some horses are extremely frightened of dogs, large or small.

9. Refreshments - Breakfast snacks, coffee, tea, drinks and water available all day.
